David Vrsecky (1:48.641), Albacete Martinez Antonio (1:49.223) and Gerhard Korber (1:49.932) topped the time sheets in the Pro category of qualifying for Season 4 of the T1 Prima truck racing championship at the Buddh International Circuit near here on Saturday. Made up of an experienced field of international truck racing drivers including from the FIA's European Truck Racing Championship for the first time, the Pro class category saw original results being overturned because of penalties.

In qualifying, Nobert Kiss (1:47.881), Ryan Smith (1:48.470) and Stephanie Halm (1:48.470) had finished in that order but were demoted following infringements. In the Champions and Super class for Indian drivers, Nagarjunaa (1:50.294) had the
